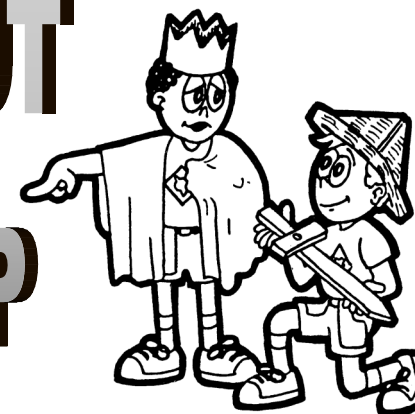

2012 Cary Adventure Camp



Cary Adventure Camp is a two or three night camping experience for Cub Scout/parent pair or a Webelos Den. Boys get the opportunity to camp in the woods in a safe and organized camp with friends and family. All of the meals for the Cub Scouts and most of the meals for the Webelos are served in our air conditioned dining hall. Webelos get the chance to cook or prepare their lunches in their campsites.

Highlights of camp are the archery and BB Gun ranges and an afternoon dip in the pool. Cub Scouts get to tackle the bouldering wall while the Webelos take on Mt.



Puff, our 22 ft inflatable climbing tower. Webelos will also have the chance to spend part of their morning on the Fairfield Lakes paddling around in a canoe.



Evenings are filled with challenges and campfires. Campwide games are held to challenge the boys while learning about this year's adventure theme. Webelos blow off steam using water artillery one night against leaders and staff. The final night of camp the Scouts take over the Council Ring and entertain their fellow campers and the staff.

2012 Sagamore Council Day Camps

In 2012 the Sagamore Council will hold five Day Camps throughout our 16 counties from June to August. Each Day Camp is either four or five days long for six to eight hours each day. Day Camp is a program that uses annual themes to energize the program for the campers.



The program includes a patriotic opening ceremony each day followed by a full day of fun and excitement. Each camp is planned and staffed by local volunteers. The staff use their resources and the natural settings to make a unique camp for the campers attending their session. Each camp will have projects for the boys to make, games for

them to play, and a chance for them to be actors in a closing campfire. All of the camps also include archery and BB gun shooting on safe and secure ranges under the direction of qualified staff. All of the camps include fun water activities, and some even offer swimming.



Day Camp is dependent on volunteers. Each Pack is responsible for one leader or parent for every six Cub Scouts or Webelos they register. It is best if leaders or parents can come each day for continuity, but we realize that is not always possible. There is no fee for the adults

unless they want to purchase a T-shirt.
