WHO CAN ATTEND?

In order to attend an NYLT course, a Scout must meet the following qualifications by the beginning of the course:

- Be at least 13 years of age and completed the seventh grade.
- Be a First Class Scout or higher.
- Should be in a leadership position within their troop, or the desire to be in a position
