

2012 Cary Adventure Camp



Cary Adventure Camp is a themed camp revolving a central idea. Each year the camp theme influences the program offered at camp.

Cub Scout Adventure Camp is an opportunity for a Cub Scout and a parent to spend some special one on one time together in the great outdoors. This family pair will travel the trails of Cary Camp together enjoying the activities and adventures waiting for them. Our staff is here to see that your son has the time of his life and that you both will remember this experience for many years to come.

Webelos Adventure camp is a little more challenging and is aimed at giving a little more independence to the Scouts. Webelos can attend Adventure Camp with his den, Pack or a parent. We have added a little more challenge to the activities to keep them growing in skills and confidence. A favorite challenge for the Webelos is Mt. Puff, our 22 foot inflatable climbing tower. Webelos are able to choose the activities they participate in each afternoon with a buddy or their den.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

Plan to arrive between 1:00 P.M. and 2:00 P.M. on the first day of your camp. Plan to depart camp by 10:00 A.M. on the last day of your camp. Baggage carriers are in the parking lot during your arrival and in campsites for your departure to carry you gear to and from the campsite. No vehicles allowed past the parking lot.

CAMPERSHIPS

Limited financial assistance may be available on an individual basis for Scouts who could not go to camp without this help. Individual applications are available at the Sagamore Council Service Center. It may be submitted after being approved by the Pack leaders. Items considered are family income, number of family members, as well as what efforts the boy and the Pack are making to help themselves ie. popcorn sales. Applications must be submitted by April 30, 2012 for consideration. Camperships are only for Sagamore Council youth attending Sagamore Council camps.

HEALTH AND MEDICAL RECORDS

Everyone who attends Adventure camp must submit part A Health History and part B photo release. For the safety of all campers it is required by the National Council that completed and signed forms be turned in and screened prior to participation in the program. Participants should make sure to bring the forms with them when they report to camp. Proper forms may be obtained at the Sagamore Council Service Center, 800-844-0537, or downloaded from www.sagamosignals.com. This form does not require a doctor's visit or signature, but must be updated by a parent each year.

All medication will be brought to the attention of the Camp Health Officer at check-in. Due to National BSA regulations, all medication will be kept locked in the Health Lodge and distributed by the camp health officer. Limited amounts of emergency medication may be carried by participants with approval of the camp health officer.

PRECAMP INFORMATION MEETING

There will be a meeting for all leaders and parents needing additional information held on Thursday, June 21, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at the Kokomo Service Center and June 28, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at Cary Camp.

CANCELATION POLICY

Payments for Camping programs are not refundable due to the fact that camp has planned, purchased, and hired staff in accordance with your attendance. To maintain financial responsibility to the members and financial supporters of the Boy Scouts of America, we cannot return funds that have already been spent in preparation for your Scout to attend camp.

Although camp fees cannot be refunded, a Scout may find another Scout to take his place at camp. That Scout may take advantage of the fees the first boy has already paid. Thus, camp fees may be *transferred* to a new Scout who registers for camp, but they may not be transferred to a Scout who has already registered and made payments for camp.

Cub Adventure Camp

(Entering Second and Third Grade)

Session 1: June 29 - July 1

This camp is for teams that consist of one boy and at least one adult (over 21) with no exceptions

Cub Adventure Camp Fee: Pair (youth and adult)

- Early Bird (Commitment by May 11, 2012): \$105
- Regular (Commitment after May 11, 2012): \$115



Webelos Adventure Camp

(Entering Fourth and Fifth Grade)

Session 1: July 5-8

Session 2: July 8-11

Session 3: July 12-15

Session 4: July 15-18

For this camp there must be one adult (over 21) for every six boys

Webelos Adventure Camp Fee: Youth

- Webelos Den incentive* (Registered by May 11, 2012): \$110
- Early Bird (Commitment by May 11, 2012): \$120
- Regular (Commitment after May 11, 2012): \$130

Webelos Adventure Camp Fee: Adult

- Early Bird (Commitment by May 11, 2012): \$65
- Regular (Commitment after May 11, 2012): \$75

* The Webelos Den Incentive price is available to all Webelos in a Pack that Registers 75 % of its Webelos for Cary Adventure Camp by May 11, 2012. The number of Webelos is based on the number of 3rd and 4th grade boys rechartered at the end of 2011

HOW TO REGISTER

Registration for Cub Adventure Camp is on a family, Den or Pack basis. If attending with your Den or Pack, forms and payment should go through the Pack coordinator. If you will attend as a family send your forms and payment directly to the Sagamore Council Service Center. One adult is required for every Cub Scout attending. Parents of twins need only bring one parent.

Registration for Webelos Adventure Camp should come through the Pack as leadership is shared and must be coordinated. One adult is required for every six (6) Webelos registered for camp. Each Pack must provide a minimum of one registered leader and one leader who is either registered or a parent.
