Sagamore Council's 5<sup>th</sup> Annual University of Scouting continues to allow Scout Leaders an opportunity to receive training for their positions, and to learn more about activities and areas in scouting that are of interest.

The U of S will take place at Pioneer High School on Saturday November 5. Doors will open at 7:45 am with the opening ceremony at 8:30 am. Classes will run from 9 AM to 4 PM, with lunch being served in the cafeteria from 12 NOON to 1 PM. The building is two levels and an elevator is available. This year's attendees DO NOT need to pre-register for specific classes. Final class lists and class locations will be handed out at the registration table.

While the District classes are open to everyone, District Committee Members must take these courses. This training includes "District Committee Opening Session" (class 1) and "District Committee Specific Training" (class 2).

Registrations received by October 21<sup>st</sup> will have a fee of \$15. Registrations received after October 21<sup>st</sup> will have a fee of \$25. Registrations should be mailed to the Council Service Center or given to your District Executive. Checks should be made payable to Sagamore Council. Registration will be accepted at the door.

Direction...

Northern Towns: take SR 16 to US 35. Turn south, the school is approximately ½ mile on your left (east).

Western, Eastern, and Southern Towns: take US 24, SR 29, or the Hoosier Heartland to US 35 north. As you approach Royal Center, US 35 N is *closed*. At the closed signs, at the edge of Royal Center, is County Road 600 W, angling to the North East. Take this road to the first stop sign, which is SR 16. Turn left (west) on SR 16, proceed to the flashing lights at the intersection of US 35. Turn left (south). The school is approximately ½ mile on your left (east).
