Application and Approval Form

Limited funds are available to help Sagamore Council Scouters meet the financial needs to attend Wood Badge. Because it is important for a Scouter to invest at least some of his or her own money in the Wood Badge experience, scholarships will normally be approved for no more than one-half of the course fees. All information should be filled in completely before submitting to the Council Office. Please mail to Sagamore Council, P.O. Box 865, Kokomo, IN 46903.

Each scholarship application will be reviewed by the Council Wood badge Coordinator who will recommend a specific amount to be awarded. Final approval or disapproval will be made by the Scout Executive after he has consulted with the applicant's District Chairman, District Executive or District Training Chairman.
